On behalf of the Jersey Shooting Federation, I would like to extend a very warm welcome to everyone participating in the 2012 Commonwealth Shooting Federation (ED) Championships.

This is the ninth occasion that Jersey has hosted the Championships, and in the 37 years since the first in 1975, there have been new ranges and many improvements to shooting facilities introduced. This year, for the first time, we are using electronic targets for some of the events and no doubt in the coming years, these targets will become the norm and enhance spectator viewing and participation of our sport.

We have also seen the impact of the pistol ban in the UK which has meant that UK pistol shooters now welcome the opportunity to compete here, with the benefit of the "Loan Pistol" initiative provided by the Jersey Pistol Club, in a full program of events not possible across the Channel.

On the other hand, many other things remain the same as all those years ago. The unmatched time and commitment of all the volunteers from the Island shooting clubs as well as shooting supporters who serve as officials and range staff, have loaned equipment, and without whom these Championships would not be possible.

We have the assistance from each of the clubs who generously make their ranges and facilities available - Jersey Rifle Association, Jersey Pistol Club, Jersey Outdoor Small Bore Rifle Club, Lecq Gun Club, St John's Shooting Club and St Lawrence Miniature Rifle Club – and we have the continuing support of all the Jersey authorities, including the Education, Sport and Culture Department, with their recognition that shooting deservedly represents one of the "national" sports of the Island.

And finally, the enthusiasm of all Championship competitors. We have 9 countries represented and 27 separately shot competitions which must be a near record. In a summer dominated by sporting triumph in the news, I wish everyone their own success, and hopefully recognition that not only are their sporting achievements well deserved, but also they come from hard fought dedication and determination.



Medal Awards

CSF(ED) Medals will be awarded according to the Constitutional rules:

5.3.1 Medals:

Official Divisional Medals shall be awarded in respect of First, Second and Third places in each of the "Medal Events", subject to the following minimum numbers of competitors:-

Five (5) competitors or more starting the event - Gold, Silver and Bronze;

Four (4) competitors starting the even - Gold and Silver only;

Three (3) competitors starting the event - Gold only;

Fewer than three competitors - no award shall be made.

Where pairs events are concerned, for these purposes the number of competitors should be read as the number of pairs.

Notwithstanding the above, however, no medal shall be awarded in any event that fails to attract starting competitors from three or more countries.

Development Competitors are not eligible for medals, but will receive Certificates.

A Brief History of the Jersey Shooting Federation (www.jsf.org.je)

During the return flight to Europe from the 1974 Commonwealth Games in Christchurch, New Zealand, several shooters got together and agreed that the European Division of the Commonwealth would hold annual shooting Championships for all the Commonwealth Games shooting disciplines. The European Division consists of England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland, Isle of Man, Guernsey, Gibraltar, Malta and Cyprus, as well as Jersey.

Scotland hosted the first Championships in September 1974 and they proved highly successful. England was nominated to host the 1975 Championships, but had to back out at the last minute. So that the impetus would not be lost, Jersey stepped into the breach and agreed to run them.

An outdoor smallbore rifle range was built in record time on private land at Val de la Mare and the Jersey Rifle Association rebuilt the 900 yard and 1,000 yard ranges at Les Landes, both being completed with just days to spare. The Jersey Championships were a great success and cemented the concept of annual Championships.

In 1979 the Jersey Shooting Federation was formed to improve co-ordination between the various independent Associations.

The JSF has 2 principal aims: to host Commonwealth Shooting Federation (European Division) Championships, when elected to do so; and to raise funds for, and to organise the participation of, a Jersey team in any CSF Championships, wherever they are held.

In 1990, at the Auckland Commonwealth Games, both Jersey and Guernsey won their first-ever Commonwealth Games Gold Medals, both in shooting. To celebrate that achievement the JSF organised a multi-event "SuperShot" competition. It was so successful that it is now held every year, as the flagship of the JSF's fund-raising efforts.

That fund-raising has been so successful that about £50,000 has been donated to date, to the JSF's selected charities, the Hospices in Jersey & Guernsey and Channel Islands Air Search.

In 1995, the first world-wide CSF Championships were held in New Delhi. They were a grand affair, opened by the President of India, with some 10,000 troops on guard duty. Malaysia hosted them in 1997, New Zealand in 1999, England in 2001, Australia in 2005 and India again in 2010. Both Australia and India are bidding to host them in 2013. Perhaps, one day, Jersey will be able to hold them; in the meantime the JSF will make every effort to send worthy teams to participate in these CSF "World" Championships as well as the European Division events.

The JSF would also like to acknowledge the enthusiasm and invaluable help of the Jersey Archery Society and the Jersey branch of the Muzzle-Loaders in staging SuperShot.


The 'Outreach' service aims to encourage residents with an existing high level of independence, to advance in their abilities and eventually enable them to live in the community, with little or no staff support.




Route between Competition Venues


